



STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Please read and sign. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to ask.

A. Respect

- Students must treat all teachers and volunteers, themselves, and fellow students with respect and honesty at all times. Lack of respect in or out of the classroom will not be tolerated.
- Students must always greet teachers and volunteers pleasantly.
- Students must not harass others verbally or physically.
- Students must respect and treat with care any and all property belonging to Ballet Afrikana and others.
- Students must not steal, convert, destroy, or damage property of Ballet Afrikana or others. Zero Tolerance.

B. Attendance and Classroom Etiquette

- Students are requested to attend all scheduled classes. If student(s) will be absent for class, please contact the instructor by phone, text, or email.
- Students are requested to be on time for all scheduled classes.
- Students are requested to be prepared for and fully participate in all required classes.
- Students are requested to follow the direction of their instructor at all times.
- Students are requested not to engage in horseplay or disruptive behavior in the classroom.
- Parents are requested not to observe classes. Please give your child(ren) an opportunity to learn and develop amongst their peers.

C. Leaving Ballet Afrikana Dance Studio

- Students may only leave Ballet Afrikana with a parent/guardian.

D. Disruptive Behavior

- Students must not physically assault, or inappropriately touch fellow students, teachers or volunteers at any time. Self-defense is no justification for such behavior.
- Student must not hit, punch, poke, pinch or participate in other physical horseplay.
- Students must not use foul language, including but not limited to, profanity, gender or racial slurs, or offensive comments about socio-economic differences.
- Students must not yell or use excessively loud voices.

E. Ballet Afrikana Studio Etiquette

- Students are requested not to bring food or drinks (other than water) in the studio.
- Students are requested not to be outside in dance clothing.
- Students are required to act responsibly at all times, regardless of their location.
- Students are requested not to violate the Dress Code.
